Decides

Article 1: To establish inter-ministerial technical working groups for the Government Information Administration System as follows:

- I. GAIS [members as listed...]
- II. e-Government [members as listed...]
- III. Residence [members as listed...]
- IV. Real Estate [members as listed...]

- V. Vehicle Registration [members as listed...]
- VI. Network [members as listed...]
- VII. User's Manual [members as listed...]
- VIII. Warehouse [members as listed...]

Article 2: The above groups have the duty of implementing the Government Administration Information System (GAIS) in a timely manner by cooperating with related Ministries or Agencies.

Article 3: His Excellency, the Secretary General of NiDA is the chair of technical working group for GAIS. The chairs of the other technical working groups have the duty of directing the work of their group in cooperation with the NiDA secretariat.

Article 4: The chair and members of each technical working group shall participate in meetings convened by the chair of the GAIS technical working group or by a member who has been given the authority to convene such meetings.

Article 5: The members of the technical working groups shall report to their own ministries or agencies about their activities with the NiDA Secretariat.

Article 6: The NiDA Secretariat, related ministries or agencies and members of the technical working groups mentioned in Article 1 have the duty of implementing this Declaration from the date of signature.
